**Foster Care Agreement**

I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that animals for which I provide foster care are kept safe and secure and provided with requirements for their daily care and well being.

I fully understand that this animal is in my care on a temporary basis only, and belongs to the Yarmouth SPCA. I further understand that the purpose of this foster care arrangement is solely to provide care for this animal and that any decisions regarding the animal's health, treatment or final disposition must be made or authorized by the Shelter Supervisor. I also agree that when the animal is ready to be made available for adoption, I will return it to the Yarmouth SPCA Shelter.
